What does the expectation scale mean?

Parent comments:

- 1) Want to see more specific comments to my child?
- 2) There is a lot of repetition.
- 3) There is a lot of regurgitation of the term review in the report card instead of specific points about the student.

Brooke Moore – teachers will be writing less on report cards. Teachers are getting used to the system.

There will no letter grades in delta for final term.

New last year – they added 4 point scale.

Working on rubrics on numeracy, english, french etc. To show what the 4 point expectation scale looks like.

Teachers will take time to incorporate this expectation scale in their practice.

A good question is to ask the teacher what is your numeracy success criteria, what is your science success scale etc.

General guidelines for numeracy, literacy would be helpful parents.
